Rally & Press Conference, steps of City Hall Monday, Nov. 4 12:00 noon

The **City Council Subcommittee on Landmarks, Public Sitings and Dispositions will VOTE at 1:00 p.m.** on the Kill the Park Plan (also known as the East Side Coastal Resiliency Plan "Preferred Alternative 4" for East River Park).

Tell City Council to VOTE NO!

BUT, If the plan passes in the subcommittee, it goes to...

Tuesday, Nov. 12, and we'll Rally & hold a press conference *again* at 10:30 a.m.

The City Council Land Use Committee will VOTE on the Kill the Park Plan at 11:00.

If the plan passes here, it goes to...

Thursday, Nov. 14, and we'll Rally *some more*, 1:00 p.m.

The City Council final VOTE on the Kill the Park Plan is at 1:30.



Whew, that's a lot of rallying and press conferencing.

We have to be there. If the plan is approved, the city will come in and roll over us and all our concerns with great big bulldozers.
